Uniform Policy

- Blazers are to be worn into school by all pupils in all year groups, unless they have Games or PE.
- Only plain watches are permitted and should be named. No jewellery is permitted except for plain, small stud earrings.
- Children from Reception through to Year 8 can wear earrings if for cultural or religious reasons their parents wish them to do so. All children are expected to remove them for PE and Games or any activities in which there is a degree of physical activity. Any child who cannot remove their own earrings should not wear them on the days when their removal is required. If a child chooses to wear earrings, the school cannot accept liability for any injury which occurs assuming the above policy has been faithfully followed.
- Hair should be worn in a neat and manageable style. No hair dye is permitted. Shoulder-length or longer hair must be tied back. No extreme hairstyles are permitted. Any hair accessories should be plain, navy.
- Year 7 and 8 girls are allowed to wear hair down, neatly.
- Make-up including nail varnish is not allowed
- All students should wear plain black leather style shoes, no trainers please. Shoes should be flat, no heels.

How to Purchase

- Uniform can be purchased from our supplier, Schoolblazer (<u>https://www.schoolblazer.com/).</u>
- The Hazelwood School Uniform Shop also has a selection of nearly new uniform and school equipment (sports equipment) for sale – all very good quality and value. The school shop is open, term time only, Monday and Wednesday 8.00am – 9.15am.
- Please Note: It may be necessary to purchase other items of sports kit such as football boots, shin pads, mouth guard, cricket whites etc. We recommend you wait until your child starts school before purchasing, so you know what is and is not a priority.

External Labelling of Sports Kit

- All items of uniform must be clearly labelled with fabric name tags. Schoolblazer offers the facility to have newly ordered items of uniform *internally labelled* (subject to their terms and conditions).
- Sports kit requires external as well as internal labelling. It is parents' responsibility to label garments prior to the start of the school term.
- Example guidance on where labels should be positioned for each item of sports kit can be seen in the picture.
- The label background should be **navy** with the type in **magenta**.
